Villa Cosmiana Duca Amerigo 2019, Tuscany, Italy £80
(THE ESTATE, FORMALLY OWNED BY DUKE AMERIGO ANTINORI OF BRINDISI, HAS BEEN BROUGHT BACK TO LIFE BY ABERGAVENNY BORN SEAN CRAIG AND HIS TEAM. THIS WINE, NAMED AFTER THE DUKE IS THEIR 'SUPER TUSCAN'. A MERLOT AND CABERNET SAUVIGNON BLEND, MATURED IN OAK THEN RESTED OVER A PERIOD OF 18 MONTHS FOR VANILLA, BAKING SPICES WITH CACAO AND VELVET TANNIN.)

Mercrey Louis Latour 2019, Burgundy, France £88
(UNOAKED PINOT NOIR FROM CÔTE CHALONNAISE IN SOUTHERN BURGUNDY, WITH PLENTY OF FRUIT, FRESHNESS & A SMOOTH FINISH)

Pesquera Tinto Reserva 2018, Ribera del Duero, Spain £95
(FROM A REGION KNOWN FOR ITS DEEPLY COLOURED, CONCENTRATED WINES, THIS 100% TINTO FINO (TEMPRANILLO) FROM THE ICONIC PESQUERA ESTATE IS PACKED FULL OF BLACK FRUIT AND SWEET SPICE. ONCE FAMOUSLY CALLED 'THE SPANISH PETRUS')

Thorn-Clarke 'Ron Thorn' Flagship Shiraz 2017, Barossa, Australia £101
(A REFLECTION OF THE QUINTESSENTIAL AUSTRALIAN, RON WAS HARD WORKING WITH A WRY SENSE OF HUMOR. A WINE THAT ONLY GETS MADE IN EXCEPTIONAL YEARS FROM THE MOST PRIZED FRUIT HAS 20 MONTHS OF BARREL MATURATION BEFORE 6 MONTHS RESTING IN THE BOTTLE PRIOR TO RELEASE. DARK FRUITS & CHOCOLATE ON THE NOSE AS WELL AS SPICE AND FIRM TANNINS)

Connétable Talbot 2018, Château Talbot, Saint-Julien, Bordeaux, France £115
(THIS MAGNIFICENT WINE IS THE 4TH GROWTH OF CHÂTEAU TALBOT, IT PAYS HOMAGE TO CONSTABLE TALBOT, AN ENGLISH SOLDIER AND GOVERNOR OF GUYENNE. THE CONNÉTABLE DE TALBOT 2018 IS MADE FROM A BLEND OF 43% CABERNET SAUVIGNON AND 57% MERLOT. THE WINE IS AGED FOR 16 MONTHS IN BARREL, OF WHICH 20% IS NEW)

Echo De Lynch Bages 2018, Pauillac, Bordeaux, France £119
(LIKE ITS BIG BROTHER, ECHO DE LYNCH-BAGES DISPLAYS THE CHARACTERISTIC TASTE, AROMAS AND LENGTH OF PAUILLAC WINES. A BLEND OF CAB SAUVIGNON, MERLOT & CAB FRANC OFFERS A RICH AND ELEGANT PALATE OF FRESH RED FRUITS (REDCURRENT AND RASPBERRY). FINE TANNINS COMBINE WITH REFRESHING ACIDITY TO PROVIDE A DELICIOUS LONG FINISH)

Château de Beaucastel, Châteauneuf-du-Pape Rouge 2009, Rhône, France £250
(THE WINES AT THIS HISTORIC PROPERTY ARE CONSISTENTLY AMONG THE FINEST IN THE REGION. A BLEND OF SOUTHERN RHÔNE RED GRAPES AND AN EXCEPTIONAL VINTAGE IN 2009. CLASSIC BEAUCASTEL WITH BLACK FRUITS, TRUFFLES, SPICE AND BITTER CHOCOLATE NOTES)
